

# WEST END LIVE

## Conditions of entry

Searching is a condition of entry to West End LIVE.

CCTV is in operation within Trafalgar Square.

**Entry is on a first come, first served basis subject to capacity. Once full, entry will be on a one out, one in basis.**

Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

No folding chairs can be used in the Square, but can be kept folded or used on Pall Mall East only.

Guests using the accessible entrance are asked to show a Nimbus Card or free West End LIVE Digital Access Pass. Those who are unable to engage in the access registration process for these have been asked to contact the organisers in advance of the event for support.

Guests using the accessible viewing area entrance must have a wristband and their name on the guest list.

Guests using the sponsors and guests entrance must have their name on the guest list.

To help protect the safety and welfare of both visitors and staff the following is a nonexclusive list of items that are prohibited from being brought into Trafalgar Square;

- Alcohol
- Glass
- Bladed items, including; pen knives, fixed bladed knives and scalpels
- Offensive weapons e.g. tasers, etc.
- Imitation or toy weapons, including toy hand grenades and guns
- Items that could be readily converted into weapons
- Component parts of weapons
- Flares or fireworks
- Party poppers and party canons
- Helium filled balloons
- Strobe lights, high intensity torches and lasers
- Hazardous materials e.g. CS gas, pepper spray, gas canisters, acids and alkalis

# WEST END LIVE

- Spray paints or cans of paint
- Powders that are not personal prescription medicines or for cosmetic purposes
- Illegal drugs
- Pointed Scissors / pointed tweezers
- Knitting Needles
- Syringes (unless required for personal medical use)
- Placards, banners flags and flag poles
- Mobile phone jamming devices
- Full facial Masks
- Items that could cause loud audible disruption e.g. whistles, megaphones, sirens, air horns, large radios / cd players
- Covert surveillance and recording equipment
- Climbing and abseiling equipment
- Tools e.g. pliers, screwdrivers, wire cutters, saws, etc.
- Animals, other than assistance animals
- Any items considered to be suspicious or unacceptable by security staff that the owner cannot provide a reasonable explanation for possessing
